



Notice on the 2025 International Artificial Intelligence Competition (IAIC)

To Organizing Committees of All Divisions:

With the advent of the artificial intelligence era, artificial intelligence education has become a new focus of education in various countries. In order to enhance the scientific and technological literacy and innovative spirit of international teenagers, and promote exchanges and learning among teenagers in the field of artificial intelligence education globally, the International Center for Artificial Intelligence in Education (ICAIE) has decided to hold the 2025 International Artificial Intelligence Competition (IAIC).

I. Organizational Structure

Organizer: International Center for Artificial Intelligence in Education (ICAIE)

Organizer: Organizing Committees of All Divisions

II. Participants

Kindergarten, primary school, and junior high school students

III. Participation Method

Participants shall register uniformly on the official competition website (<http://icaie.net/>) (registration channel will be opened soon). After qualification review and screening, division-level selection competitions will be held, and outstanding candidates will be shortlisted for the global final. The competition items and specific rules can be found on the official website.



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IV. Schedule

The competition consists of selection competitions and the international final. After this notice is issued, the organizing committees of each division shall organize division-level selection competitions according to actual conditions. The tentative schedule is as follows:

- 1.May–October 2025:** Selection competitions
- 2.November 2025:** Announcement of the international finalists list
- 3.January or February 2026:** International final (specific time and venue will be notified separately)

V. Evaluation Methods

- 1.First, second, and third prizes will be set for each competition item.
- 2.Excellent Organization Awards and Excellent Instructor Awards will be established.

VI. Other Matters

The competition adheres to the principles of voluntariness and fairness. Expenses such as transportation, accommodation, and insurance incurred by participants shall be borne by themselves.

(The above participation and award rules are formulated, revised, and interpreted by the International Center for Artificial Intelligence in Education, and the organizing committees of all divisions shall implement them simultaneously.)
